Subchapter 2.4 Leadership Development Programs

Subchapter 2.4-100. General Provisions

Sec. 2.4-101. Purpose

a. The leadership program at UT Tyler encompasses both opportunities for personal leadership development as well as group leadership development. Although the program is growing and expanding, there is currently one targeted leadership opportunity available to students: Emerging Leaders. Other organizations and programs offer additional opportunities for students to develop their leadership skills and abilities.

Subchapter 2.4-200. Administration

Sec. 2.4-201. Leadership Advisory Board

a. The Director of Student Life and Leadership has oversight for the leadership development program developed by the office along with a leadership advisory board made up of three faculty members, three staff members, three students, and three community members who will serve for two-year terms.

Subchapter 2.4-300. Emerging Leaders

Sec. 2.4-301. Program Description

a. Emerging Leaders is a six-week course targeted to freshman students who are interested in the topic of leadership and in developing themselves. One workshop is offered each week on a topic to facilitate this type of development within students. In addition to the weekly workshops, an overnight retreat is offered where students have the opportunity to participate in a ropes course.
